### **Global Discovery Programme Universiti Brunei Darussalam – ASEAN University Network Summer Camp 2026 (UBD–AUN Summer Camp 2026)**

#### 1. Programme Overview

Universiti Brunei Darussalam (UBD), in collaboration with the ASEAN University Network (AUN), is pleased to invite nominations for the **UBD–AUN Summer Camp 2026**.

This immersive, in-person short-term programme brings together undergraduate students from AUN member universities to explore contemporary regional and global challenges through academic exchange, cultural engagement, and experiential learning.

#### 3. Programme Fee and Financial Support

The total value of the programme is USD1,500 per participant, which covers:

- On-campus accommodation
- Daily meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- Local transportation, including airport transfers
- Academic sessions, workshops, and cultural excursions

In line with the UBD's strong commitment to regional engagement and student mobility, **Universiti Brunei Darussalam provides a substantial subsidy** for the programme. **Participants are required to pay only a subsidised programme fee of USD 100 / BND 130.**

Participants / sending university are responsible for the following expenses:

- International airfare
- Travel and health insurance
- Personal expenses
- Subsidised programme fee of USD 100 / BND 130

#### 4. Eligibility Criteria

The International Relations Office (IRO) of each sending university may nominate **up to six (6) students** who meet the following criteria:

- Be currently enrolled as a full-time student in an undergraduate (Bachelor's Degree) programme at AUN member universities.
- Be officially nominated by the International Relations Office (IRO) of the sending university.
- Demonstrate interest in the theme of the programme, particularly in issues related to coastal cities, climate resilience, and sustainable development.
- Be able to participate actively in English, as the programme will be conducted in English.
- Be available for the full duration of the programme, including all official academic, cultural, and group activities.

#### 5. Required Nominee Information

Each nomination should include the following details:

- Personal Information: Full name (as per passport), email address, gender, date of birth, nationality.
- Education Background: University name, faculty, major/field of study, current year of study.
- T-shirt Size (refer to the measurement chart in Appendix).
- Special Dietary Requirements (e.g., no dietary restrictions, halal, vegetarian, etc.)

#### 6. Nomination Process and Selection Process

  - Once the nominated students have submitted the above application. An alphanumeric 'OASys Application Code' will be generated. This code is required for Step 2 below.

## Appendix Accommodation Details

Participants will be housed at The Core Residential College within the UBD Campus. The accommodation style is apartment-like, designed for a single-gender group of five students to share one apartment unit. Each participant will be allocated a single, air-conditioned study bedroom. The apartment features communal areas including a toilet, kitchen, living room, and laundry facilities for shared use among the occupants.

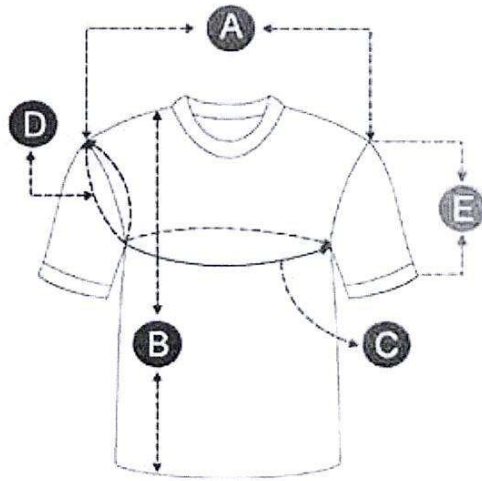
