

Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET

Information on Scholarship Call 2027/28 (closing date 1st March 2027)

[ASEA-UNINET](#) supports the exchange of knowledge between partner universities and member countries in Europe and South-East Asia. In this context, the network supports the exchange of scientists and postgraduates and the transfer of knowledge associated.

The [Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET](#) offers scholarships for full PhD studies, postdoc research stays and for studies in the field of music practice at an [ASEA-UNINET member university* in Austria](#) to students and researchers **from Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam**.

Citizenship: Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam (only applicants who hold the citizenship of one of these countries are eligible to apply)

Target Country: Austria

Area of Study: All fields of study: Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities

Types of Grants:

Full PhD Grant

Target Group: Postgraduates who want to carry out a full doctorate/PhD-programme in Austria and fulfill the requirements for admission and who have completed their studies at a university outside Austria

Duration: 36 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro + a mobility subsidy of 300 Euro per month

Postdoc Grant

Target Group: Postdocs who are involved in teaching and research at an [ASEA-UNINET member university*](#) in Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam

Duration: 4 to 6 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

Music Practice Grant

Target Group: Undergraduates (or higher) in the field of music practice (instrumental and vocal performance, composition, and conducting)

Duration: 9 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

Maximum Age: Undergraduates, Graduates and Postgraduates: 35 years; Postdocs: 45 years

Funding Organisation: OeAD-GmbH on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Women, Science and Research - BMFWF in cooperation with ASEA-UNINET

Language Proficiency: Very good knowledge of English and/or German

Selection Process: After an examination of the formal requirements and an evaluation of the applications by experts, the candidates will be invited to a personal (face-to-face) interview. Applicants for the Music Practice Grant have to participate in an audition process including a mandatory interview (for further information see [here](#)). Final decision by the BMFWF.

Closing date for applications: 1st March 2027 (for Music Practice Grant: 15th December 2026)

Online at www.scholarships.at. The link to the online application tool will become available in the grant announcement by **15th September 2026**.

Documents and Uploads to be submitted with the Online Application:

- Research proposal (in the field of music: CV & Audition Registration)
- Letter of Consent of the supervisor at the Austrian host university (for Music Practice: "Letter of Endorsement" from the Austrian music universities after successful auditions process)
- Two Letters of Recommendation by university lecturers (for PhD applications: a Letter of Recommendation must be provided by an [ASEA-UNINET member university](#)* in Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam or the Philippines.)
- Proof of a very good command of English (B2 or C1, depending on the chosen degree programme)
- Copy of passport
- University graduation certificates as well as an English or German translation.
